NORDIC VACCINE MEETING

Vaccines, especially those given in the paediatric vaccination programmes have drastically lowered the morbidity and mortality in infectious diseases. The best example is smallpox vaccination which made it possible to eradicate smallpox in 1978. Other campaigns which have markedly reduced incidences of infectious diseases – but still not achieved eradication – are those for polio eradication and increased measles vaccination.

In recent years several new vaccines have been included in the paediatric programmes. Examples are conjugated pneumococcal vaccine, rotavirus vaccine and vaccine against human papilloma virus (HPV). Other vaccines being considered or already included in such programmes are those against varicellae and hepatitis B.

The biannual Nordic vaccine meetings have for decades offered possibilities for vaccinology experts from those countries to meet and discuss the latest news in vaccine development. Importantly, the meetings have also offered opportunities to discuss and compare vaccination policies in the Nordic countries.

The Nordic vaccination meeting in 2010 will be arranged as a Berzelius symposium by the Swedish Society of Medicine in collaboration with Karolinska Institutet and the Swedish Institute for Infectious Disease Control. We think we can offer a guarantee of emphasis on highest possible scientific quality and we look forward to seeing you in Stockholm in October 2010.
